



Cabled Hat

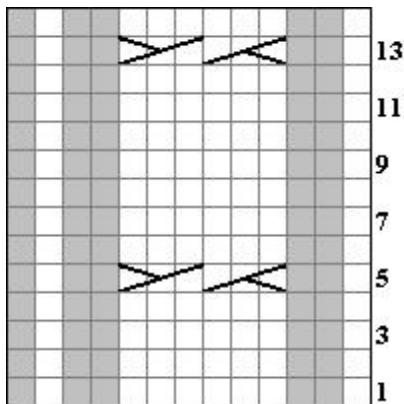
Finished Size: To fit a 20 inch head

Yarn: Patons Décor, 75% Acrylic - 25% Wool, 3.5 ounces - 210 yards, one ball.

Needles: 16 inch circular and 3 double point needles size US 8 (5 mm)

Gauge: **TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE**

6.5 stitches to the inch in k1, p1 ribbing; without stretching



Pattern: knit in the round over a multiple of 13 stitches
 Round 1 and all non-crossing rounds: *k1, p2, k6, p2, k1, p1;
 repeat from*
 Round 5 and 13: *k1, p2, place 3 stitches on cable needle and hold
 in back, knit 3, knit 3 from cable needle, p2, k1, p1; repeat from*.

To make the hat: Make two tassels, set aside.

Cast-on 104 stitches; join being careful not to twist. Work knit 1, purl 1 ribbing for 10 rounds.

Start working from the chart repeating the cable chart 8 times around.

Continue working in pattern; repeating rows 7 to 14 (inclusive) six times or until hat is long enough.

Divide the stitches onto two needles and close the top with 3-needle bind-off worked with wrong sides together.

Sew a tassel onto each corner. Weave in ends, block as needed.
